Commissioner Karschner called the meeting to order and asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the prior meeting.

A. NEW ANNUITIES OF RETIRED MEMBERS

- Christopher Moser selected Option One: A monthly benefit payable for the rest of his life. At the time of his death, if he has not received at least the total of his member account balance plus the present value of the county annuity, with a guarantee of receiving at least \$120,480.71 in payments (about 130 monthly payments), his designated beneficiary will receive the balance.

Mr. Boston selected Option Three (3): A monthly pension of \$2,870.24 payable for his lifetime. If he predeceases his designated survivor annuitant, his survivor annuitant will receive a monthly payment of \$1,435.12 (50% of his pension) for the rest of her lifetime. If both he and his survivor annuitant die before the cumulative monthly pension payments equal or exceed \$172,870.91, the amount of his accumulated deductions at his annuity start date, his designated beneficiaries would receive a lump sum payment equal to the excess of his accumulative pension payments received to date. Kimberly Boston is his survivor annuitant.
