## A. NEW ANNUITIES OF RETIRED MEMBERS

• **Jill Schoepflin choose No Option**: A monthly benefit payable for the rest of her life representing the total member annuity and county annuity. At the time of her death, if she hasn't received at least the amount of your member balance at retirement, your designated beneficiary will receive the balance.

Monthly benefit with a guarantee of receiving at least \$79,978.17 in payments (about 46 monthly payments) plus a partial payment for August 2024 of \$1,217.05.

Monthly Benefit - \$1,714.94 Monthly Benefit Partial payment for August, 2024: \$1,217.05

• Mr. Vezendy selected Option Four C: A lump-sum payment of his member account balance plus a monthly benefit payable for the rest of his life, and upon his death, the same monthly benefit will continue to your designated beneficiary, if still living.
