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WRIT OF EXECUTION NOTICE

This paper is a Writ of Execution. It has been issued because there is a judgment against you. It may cause your property to be held or taken to pay the judgment. 1. \$300 statutory exemption
2. Bibles, school books, sewing machines, uniforms and equipment
3. Most wages and unemployment compensation
4. Social Security benefits
5. Certain retirement funds and accounts
6. Certain veteran and armed forces benefits
7. Certain insurance proceeds
8. Such other exemptions as may be provided by law.

ADDITIONALLY, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO FILE A MOTION TO OPEN OR STRIKE THE JUDGMENT, AND TO DO SO YOUR OR YOUR ATTORNEY MUST FILE A MOTION WITH THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY IMMEDIATELY.
