- (2) Deliver the form or mail it to the Sheriff's Office at the address noted.

You should come to court ready to explain your exemption.

If you do not come to court and prove your exemptions, you may lose some of your property.

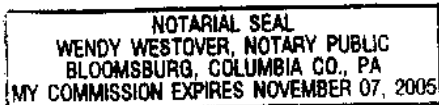


